Environmental monitoring is a proceduralized recurring set of activities for evaluating air and surfaces for viable or non-viable particles as well as other environmental variables. The chief function of environmental monitoring is informational feedback on environmental control, disinfection and sanitization activities, and personnel gowning, hygienic, and aseptic practices. Environmental monitoring works in parallel with cleanroom facility qualification. Cleanrooms are classified according to the maximum count per cubic meter of particles at or above a specified diameter. Most of the world's...
