

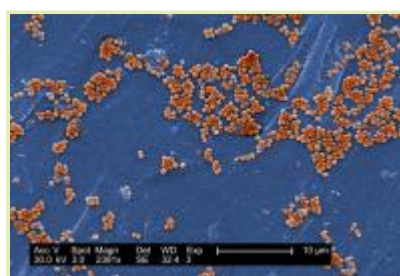

Abstract
