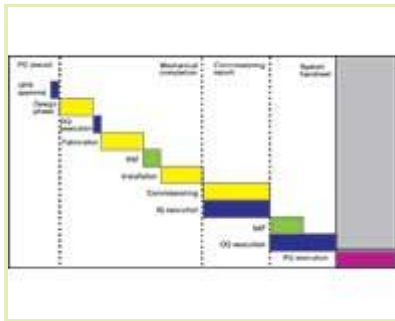


Reduced Validation Effort—Approaches Used and Lessons Learned
